Morning Dew

Transient dewdrops are speckled on porcelain leaves and cool surfaces, capturing nature in a delicate state of flux. This is part of an ongoing investigation blurring the lines between the glaze and the clay body, designed to preserve a transitory state of flux – in this case, between fluidity and solidity. The viscous glaze emulates the naturally occurring process of dew forming, making visible the intangible and often unseen changes in nature in an ephemeral landscape. The luminosity and translucency of the materials invite the quiet observation of fleeting moments found in the mundane.
